

Tournament Rules

Roster

Maximum 16 players for 7v7 teams and 20 players for 9v9 teams.

Game Time

All matches consist of two 20-minute halves.

Substitutions

Substitutions are made on the fly for all age groups.

Throw-Ins

Throw-ins are used for all age groups. For younger age groups, referees will be less strict on foul throws.

Free Kicks

Both direct and indirect free kicks apply for all age groups.

Penalty Kicks

A penalty kick is awarded when, in the referee's opinion, a clear scoring opportunity is denied by an infraction. This does not automatically result in a red card.

Slide Tackling

Slide tackling is permitted for all age groups.

Forfeits

Teams have a five-minute grace period from the scheduled kickoff (or adjusted start time due to unforeseen circumstances). All forfeits must be approved by the Tournament Director before becoming official.

Red Cards

A player receiving a red card is dismissed for the remainder of the match and may also miss the following game at the referee's discretion. The team will play short-handed for five minutes before being allowed to substitute another player.

Standings & Tiebreakers

If teams are tied in the standings, tiebreakers will be applied in the following order: 1. Head-to-Head (only when two teams are tied), 2. Goal Difference, 3. Goals Scored, 4. Goals Against, 5. Coin Toss. If three or more teams are tied, Head-to-Head is skipped.

Multiple Teams

Players may play for two teams only if the teams are in two different age groups.

Tournament Authority

The Tournament Committee's interpretation of the rules is final. Any matter not covered above will be decided by the Tournament Director.
